He later pursued a research fellowship at the Institute of Pathology, Lausanne University Hospital in Switzerland, under the mentorship of Prof. Sabina Berezowska. His research focused on applying molecular techniques to the assessment of multiple lung tumour nodules and integrating digital pathology into lung cancer diagnostics.

During this time, he also completed the inaugural European Master's in Molecular Pathology through the Université Côte d'Azur in Nice, France, including a research project on HER2 alterations in non-small cell lung cancer (NSCLC).

Dr. Keyter is an active member of the International Association for the Study of Lung Cancer (IASLC), the European Society of Pathology (ESP), and the Association for Molecular Pathology (AMP) (among others). With expertise in molecular and thoracic pathology, he brings a patient-centred approach and a strong commitment to advancing diagnostic precision and innovation at Holm Pathologists.
